On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Franzen the minutes of the June 19, 2007, Committee of the Whole meeting be approved as amended and the reading of said minutes be dispensed with, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Nystrom seconded by Commissioner Thiede the Board supports the Premises Permit Application of Ski Gull for a Class B Premises Permit to be held at the Bada-Boom, subject to all State Laws and upon approval of said Application, the applicant submitting a copy of reports required by the State, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Nystrom seconded by Commissioner Thiede the Board supports the Minnesota Lawful Gambling Application of the Oak Street Chapel for an Exempt Permit to be held August 12, 2007, at the Crow Wing County Fair Grounds, subject to approval of the Town of Oak Lawn, all State Laws and the applicant submitting a copy of reports required by the State, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Nystrom seconded by Commissioner Thiede the Board supports the Minnesota Lawful Gambling Application of the Brainerd Lakes Chapter – Delta Waterfowl for an Exempt Permit to be held August 24, 2007, at The Old Waterfall, subject all State Laws and the applicant submitting a copy of reports required by the State, all members voted "AYE".

Commissioner Franzen offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Commissioners of Crow Wing County, Minnesota, having examined into the allegations of the application of Crow Wing County dated June 20, 2007, for cancellation of County Auditor's Certificate of Forfeiture as to certain lands described in said application, and find the allegations of said application to be true, approves said application and recommends that the same be granted.

Which resolution being seconded by Commissioner Nystrom was duly adopted, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Houge seconded by Commissioner Nystrom the Board, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Chapter 180, approves the appointment of John Radinovich as the Crow Wing County Mining Inspector, effective upon taking an Oath of Office; and further, the Board sets the salary at \$8 per hour, not to exceed twelve hours per week, and not to exceed \$7,500 per year, with actual traveling expenses not to exceed \$1,200 in any one year, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Nystrom the Board, upon recommendation of the Health Department, approves the Agreement between Crow Wing County and Cuyuna Range Medical Center for the usage of space to provide services for the Women Infant and Children Clinic, and the Chairman and County Administrator are authorized to sign said Agreement, upon approval of the County Attorney, all members voted "AYE".

Commissioner Thiede offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Commissioners of Crow Wing County, Minnesota, agrees to enter into a Juvenile Accountability Block Grant Agreement between the State of Minnesota, acting through its Commissioner of Public Safety, Office of Justice Programs, and the Crow Wing County Auditor's Office for a grant of \$18,205.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Chairman and County Administrator are authorized to sign said Agreement, upon approval of the County Attorney.

Which resolution being seconded by Commissioner Nystrom was duly adopted, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Franzen seconded by Commissioner Nystrom the Board affirms the following Committee change: Commissioner Houge to serve on the Planning Commission as the County Board representative, replacing Commissioner Tautges, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Houge seconded by Commissioner Nystrom the Board affirms the appointment James Belfiori to serve on the Planning Commission as the representative from County Commissioner District 5 for a term expiring January 31, 2008, all members voted "AYE", except Commissioner Thiede voted "NAY".

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Nystrom, the Board on recommendation of the Facilities Manager accepts the quote of \$36,188.00 from Holden Electric to connect the main generator located in the Central Plant to the Law Enforcement and further, said project is to be paid from the general building fund, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Nystrom the Board authorizes the Sanitary Management District to seek an extension on the current grant in the amount of \$40,000 which expires on June 30, 2007 between Crow Wing County and the State of Minnesota through its Commissioner of the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency with the extension expiration date of June 30, 2009. All members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Franzen seconded by Commissioner Nystrom the Board upon recommendation of the County Sheriff, authorizes Communications Supervisor, Scott Heide to attend the APCO Conference to be held August 5 – 9, 2007 in Baltimore Maryland (ICAC), with all expenses to be reimbursed from the County Sheriff's Budget, all members voted "AYE".

Commissioner Franzen offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Commissioners of Crow Wing County, Minnesota, approves Amendment No. 1 to the Grant Contract between the State of Minnesota, acting through its Commissioner of Public Safety, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, and Crow Wing County for a grant for the 2005 Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program, which extends the original Grant Contract through December 31, 2007.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Chairman and County Administrator are authorized to sign said Amendment, upon approval of the County Attorney.

Which resolution being seconded by Commissioner Houge was duly adopted, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Houge the Board, upon recommendation of the Land Commissioner, receives the appraisals of Gregory Company Real Estate Appraisal for the Braun/Crow Wing County Land Exchange; and further, payment be made to the appraiser in the amount of \$3,490 for appraisal services, and the County Auditor is authorized to issue the warrant from the Forfeited Tax Sale Fund, and in addition, the applicant will pay the difference in value of \$5,000 as per Minnesota Statutes, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Franzen seconded by Commissioner Houge the Board amends the legal description of Tract #123 on the 2007 Tax Forfeited Land Sale list excepting out that part to be reserved for snowmobile trail use with legal description to be provided by County Surveyor and further value is amended as follows, all members voted "AYE".

- o Land Value (as per Co.Assessor) \$57,700
- o Timber Value (as per Co.Land Comm.) \$ 1,410
- o Grand Total Value \$59,110.

On motion of Commissioner Thiede, seconded by Commissioner Houge the Board approves the final plat of Sunset Knoll CIC involving 6 lots on 16.45 acres on property described as Govt. Lot 2, Sec. 29-137-28, Ideal Township with the condition that Part 4C of the declarations be revised to prohibit transitory renting or leasing of units, and the language be approved by the County Attorney's office prior to the recording of the Final Plat, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Houge the Board, upon recommendation of the County Planner, authorizes the County Auditor to release surety in the amount of \$3,600 posted for road construction within the plat of SAND CREEK, all members voted "AYE".

Motion by Commissioner Thiede, seconded by Commissioner Franzen the Board approves the Sno Serpents Cross Lake Spur reroute of Trail NENE Sec 26-T137-R27 and further authorizes a snowmobile trail permit be issued, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Franzen, seconded by Commissioner Thiede the Board approves the Merrifield Marathons Inc. snowmobile trail reroute SWNE Sec 11 – T134-R28 and further authorizes a snowmobile trail permit be issued, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Nystrom, seconded by Commissioner Houge the Board accepts the low quote of Anderson Brothers for repair or replacement of sidewalks around the County complex, all members voted "aye".

The Board received the annual report from Lutheran Social Services Senior Companion program.

Commissioner Thiede offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Commissioners of Crow Wing County, Minnesota, approves Amendment No. 1 to the Joint Powers Agreement between the State of Minnesota, Department of Human Services and Crow Wing County, to provide MinnesotaCare eligibility determination for \$30 per application, with said Amendment extending the term to June 30, 2008, and increasing the total obligation by \$950.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Chairman and County Administrator are authorized to sign said Agreement, upon approval of the County Attorney.

Which resolution being seconded by Commissioner Nystrom was duly adopted, all members voted "AYE".

The Human Services Director gave the Board an overview of the Crisis Nursery and Child Welfare Grants.

The Human Services Director gave her Director's Report.

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Houge the Human Services Director is authorized to advertise and hire to fill a vacant regular, full time County Agency Social Worker (CPS) position created by the resignation of Janell Smart, at a salary range of \$2,989-\$5,094 per month (Minnesota Teamsters Public and Law Enforcement Employees' Union, Local No. 320 (Social Services Unit) Labor Agreement & Minnesota Merit System), in accordance with the County Affirmative Action Policy and subject to 2007 budget guidelines, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Houge the Board then convened to a closed meeting to discuss contract negotiations, all members voted "AYE".

Present were all County Board members, County Administrator David Hamilton, Human Resources Director Tamra Laska, County Attorney Donald Ryan, Administrative Coordinator Therese Norwood and Administrative Assistant Terrie Walseth.

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Houge the Board then reconvened to the County Board meeting, all members voted "AYE".

Commissioner Thiede offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, Crow Wing County has applied to the Commissioner of Transportation for a grant from the Minnesota State Transportation Fund for construction of a Local Road Improvement Project, Project No. 18-621-19, right turn lane and bypass lane installation at the intersection of CSAH 21/CR 123,

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Transportation has given notice that the funding for this local road improvement project is available and

WHEREAS, the amount of the grant has been determined to be \$43,800 by reason of the available Local Road Improvement funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Crow Wing County does hereby agree to the terms and conditions of the grant consistent with Minnesota Statutes, section 174.52, subdivision 5, and will pay any additional amount by which the cost exceeds the estimate, and will return to the Minnesota State Transportation Fund any amount appropriated for the road project, but not required.

Which resolution being seconded by Commissioner Houge was duly adopted, all members voted "AYE".

Commissioner Thiede offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, Crow Wing County has applied to the Commissioner of Transportation for a grant from the Minnesota State Transportation Fund for construction of Local Road Improvement Project No. 18-621-17, intersection safety improvements to CSAH 21/CR 131, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Transportation has given notice that the funding for this local road improvement project is available and determined to be in the amount of \$250,000, and

WHEREAS, after receiving bids for the project, it was determined that there is sufficient funding remaining to perform another safety improvement, and the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) has agreed to allow the excess funding to be used on such an improvement, and

WHEREAS, bids received for that second project, S.A.P. 18-621-18, guardrail removal and culvert replacement on CSAH 21 still left sufficient funds to perform another safety improvement, and the MnDOT has agreed to allow the excess funding to be used on such an improvement, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the best use of these funds is to install a right turn lane and bypass lane at the intersection of CSAH 21/CR 123 and identified as Project No. 18-621-19, which will also allow for safer turning movements at the intersections.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Crow Wing County, Minnesota, authorizes the County Auditor to advertise for sealed bids for the construction of Project No. 18-621-18, the CSAH 21 culvert replacement/safety improvement project, upon completion of Plans and Specifications and approval from Mn/DOT.

Which resolution being seconded by Commissioner Houge was duly adopted, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Houge the Board, upon recommendation of the County Highway Engineer, accepts the following bills to be included with other bills for payment, all members voted "AYE".

- Gale-Tec Engineering, Inc. in the amount of \$2,342.75 for Geotechnical Engineering for RSS Design along Riverside Drive (CSAH 20)

- Arrow Printing in the amount of \$300.80 for Mail Boat Brochures for the Paul Bunyan Scenic Byway Association

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Houge the Board, upon recommendation of the County Highway Engineer, accepts the counteroffer of \$1,000 from Earl A. and Jeanette Bath for right-of-way acquisition on County State Aid Highway 10 (S.P. 18-610-05), to be paid from the Road and Bridge Fund, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Houge the Board, upon recommendation of the County Highway Engineer, approves the Petition for Maintenance Service received from property owners in First Assessment District for one-time maintenance in 2007 to Paine Avenue, subject to County Policy on Undesignated Roads in Unorganized Territory, all members voted "AYE".

The Board received and reviewed the County Highway Engineer's Report of Maintenance Activities and Construction Projects.

The Board received a Farewell Report from County Highway Engineer Duane Blanck.

The County Administrator offered dates for a joint meeting with City of Brainerd for discussion regarding the Brainerd Regional Human Services Campus and the Board requested the following dates: July 12 at 3:00 p.m. or July 17 at 5:00 p.m. with meeting to be conducted at the Brainerd City Hall Council Chambers and further requested that Transit be added to the agenda items to be discussed.
