

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
CROW WING COUNTY, MINNESOTA  
Meeting held on August 14, 2007

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned session on August 14, 2007, at 9:00 a.m.

All members were present.

Open Forum – none.

On motion of Commissioner Houge seconded by Commissioner Nystrom the minutes of the July 24, 2007, meeting be approved as published and the reading of said minutes be dispensed with, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Houge the agenda of the August 14, 2007, meeting be approved as published, with the following amendments, all members voted "AYE".

1. Add "Building & Grounds Committee Recommendation" under Agenda Item #6e, Committee Reports.
2. Add "Resignation of County Planner" under Agenda Item #11, Planning & Zoning.

On motion of Commissioner Nystrom seconded by Commissioner Franzen the Board accepts a donation of \$2,000 from Ruttger's Bay Lake Lodge for the Highway 371 Rest Area and Lakes Area Welcome Center, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Nystrom seconded by Commissioner Franzen the Board accepts a donation of \$450 from the ETOC Company, Inc. for the Highway 371 Rest Area and Lakes Area Welcome Center, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Nystrom seconded by Commissioner Franzen the Board supports the Minnesota Lawful Gambling Application of the Minnesota Sheriff's Association for two Exempt Permits (Conference Raffle and ATV Raffle) to be held September 21, 2007, at the Ruttger's Bay Lake Lodge, subject to the approval of the Town of Bay Lake, all State Laws and the applicant submitting a copy of reports required by the State, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Nystrom seconded by Commissioner Franzen the Board supports the Premises Permit Renewal Application of C-I Quarterbacks for a Class B Premises Permit to be held at the Wolfhound, subject to the approval of the Town of Fairfield, all State Laws and upon approval of said Application, the applicant submitting a copy of reports required by the State, all members voted "AYE".

Commissioner Thiede offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

CROW WING COUNTY ADULT DRUG COURT  
CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL BY LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT

WHEREAS, the Crow Wing County Adult Drug Court is a post-plea, pre-conviction problem-solving approach that uses the power of the court in collaboration with other criminal justice partners and community members (prosecutors, defense counsel, treatment providers, probation officers, law enforcement, educational and vocational experts, community leaders, clergy, and others) to closely monitor the defendant's progress toward sobriety and recovery through ongoing treatment, frequent and random drug testing, regular mandatory check-in court appearances, and the use of a range of immediate sanctions and incentives to foster behavior change to reduce criminal behavior and enhance public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County of Crow Wing certifies that the Crow Wing County Adult Drug Court, being located within our jurisdiction, has Crow Wing County's approval to apply for and receive funding from the State Court Administrator's Office, State of Minnesota.

Which resolution being seconded by Commissioner Franzen was duly adopted, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Houge the Board, upon recommendation of the County Assessor, agrees to enter into a renewal of Assessor Purchase of Services Agreement between Crow Wing County and Dale W. Carter for purposes of providing assessment services for all real estate and personal properties as directed by the County Assessor for New Construction Permits in Various Taxing Districts throughout the County for 2008 Assessment; and further, compensation for all services rendered will remain the same at \$15 per parcel, with the said Agreement terminating on July 1, 2008, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Nystrom the Board directs the Purchasing Agent to obtain quotes for shredding of confidential material, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Nystrom seconded by Commissioner Houge the Board, upon recommendation of the Facilities Manager, accepts the low quote of Marsden Building Maintenance Services and authorizes the work be performed accordingly, subject to receipt of a Certificate of Insurance required by the County; and further, said services are to be paid from the Facilities Budget, all members voted "AYE".

Committee Reports:

- The Chairman appointed Bruce Johnson to serve on the Crow Wing County Sanitary Management District Board as the representative from County Commissioner District 5.
- Commissioner Tautges gave an update on South Country Health Alliance.
- Commissioner Thiede gave an update on the Geographic Information System Steering Committee.

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Houge the Board, upon recommendation of the Building and Grounds Committee, directs the County Administrator to seek costs and proposals for construction litigation, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Franzen the Board, upon recommendation of the County Highway Engineer, authorizes the County Highway Department to proceed with building a second entrance to the Eagleview Elementary School located on County State Aid Highway 11 and re-mark existing turn and bypass lanes; and further, the school district shall be responsible for paving the new entrance and providing internal signage to direct traffic, all members voted "AYE".

Commissioner Franzen offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, various funding programs at the federal and state government levels are available to Crow Wing County and its political subdivisions for the construction and reconstruction of bridges, and

WHEREAS, Crow Wing County has reviewed the pertinent data on bridges requiring replacement, rehabilitation, or removal, and has identified those bridges that are high priority and that may require replacement, rehabilitation or removal with the next five years.

WHEREAS, based on current State guidelines, the County Highway Department will complete the MDA valuations and summary to secure easements of record required on S.P. 18-602-25, and

WHEREAS, once completed, the MDA valuations will be on file in the Offices of the County Auditor and the County Highway Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of County Commissioners of Crow Wing County, Minnesota, accepts the Appraiser's report of current land values and authorizes the County Highway Engineer to prepare MDA valuations and extend offers and negotiate for the necessary right-of-way for S.P. 18-602-25.

On motion of Commissioner Nystrom seconded by Commissioner Houge the Board, upon recommendation of the Land Commissioner, accepts the quote of William R. 5. The rezoning will not create a density inconsistent with the surrounding area along the shoreline.

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Houge the County Sheriff is authorized to advertise to create a new Correctional Officer hiring list, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Houge, upon recommendation of the County Attorney, that an easement across the following described County land be granted to the City of Brainerd, all members voted "AYE".

A 10 foot wide perpetual utility easement over, under and across those parts of the Southwest Quarter and the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 31, Township 45, Range 30, Crow Wing County, Minnesota, lying parallel, contiguous with and 10 feet North of the existing northerly right-of-way line of County Road Number 117 and East of the existing easterly right-of-way line of County Road Number 45.

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Franzen the County Attorney is authorized to execute the Stipulation for Settlement in the matter of United States of America v. Henderson, et. all., in which Crow Wing County is named a party purely for the purpose of dealing with real estate tax obligations as they become due; and further, said Stipulation establishes Crow Wing County's priority for payment of any real estate taxes from settlement funds in said lawsuit, all members voted "AYE".

The County Administrator informed the Board that a representative from the Carey Group is scheduled to be present at the next County Board meeting to present a proposal regarding the Juvenile Detention Center. He also informed the Board that a letter will be sent to surrounding counties to see if they are interested in pursuing a joint effort regarding said issue.

A presentation was made by the County Auditor's Office regarding the 2008 Budget Overview Summary.
