Commissioner Franzen offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, in lieu of a petition a letter was received from WIEC Properties, LLC the owner of the Plat of BAKA, First Assessment District, for the establishment of the road within said plat, that said road is identified as Ponds Edge Trail, and

WHEREAS, the County Highway Engineer has examined the proposed road and the overall conditions of the development within the plat, and

WHEREAS, the conditions and requirements of the Minimum Road Construction Requirements for the First Assessment District are considered satisfied by the developer providing for a bituminous surface on the road within the plat in lieu of one-third of the lots being fully developed, and

WHEREAS, conducting a Public Hearing regarding said letter is considered unnecessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Commissioners of Crow Wing County, Minnesota, acting for and on behalf of the First Assessment District, establishes the road known as Ponds Edge Trail within the plat of BAKA as a Town Road.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Highway Engineer is authorized to provide adequate maintenance and take other actions as necessary in exercising appropriate jurisdiction of the above established Town Road.

Which resolution being seconded by Commissioner Nystrom was duly adopted, all members voted "AYE".

The Board received an update on the CSAH 3 (Mill Road) reconstruction project from the County Highway Engineer.

The Board tables the Amendment of Ordinance Regulating Liquor Licenses as it Relates to Outside Music and requested the County Attorney's Office review with the Sheriff's Office the number of complaints since the time of the public hearing.

The Board received a report from the County Administrator on the revisions to the recently approved Snowmobile Trail requested by Sno Serpents Snowmobile Club.

The Board received the 2006 Medical Examiner report.

On motion of Commissioner Thiede, seconded by Commissioner Franzen the Board, upon the recommendation of the County Administrator approves the recommendation to return the Parks Department and its three existing staffing positions to the Land Department as a separate division under the administrative leadership of the Land Commissioner and that Land Department staff be offered the opportunity to consider sharing the Parks Division responsibilities, and that the Parks Fund and its funding mechanisms be maintained as a separate resource for future park projects, all members voted "AYE" except Commissioners Nystrom and Franzen voted "NAY".

On motion of Commissioner Nystrom seconded by Commissioner Houge the County Sheriff is authorized to advertise and hire to fill two vacant regular, full time Communication Officer positions created by the resignations of Sue Olund and Bridget Larson, at a range of \$2,775 - \$3,380 per month (Law Enforcement Labor Services, Inc. (Local #16) (Dispatchers and Correctional Officers) Labor Agreement, in accordance with the County Affirmative Action Policy and subject to 2007 budget guidelines, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Nystrom seconded by Commissioner Houge the Human Services Director is authorized to advertise and hire to fill a vacant regular, full time County Agency Social Worker (CPS) position created by Bobbie Stay's acceptance of the Social Worker/LTC position, at a salary range of \$2,989-\$5,094 per month (Minnesota Teamsters Public and Law Enforcement Employees' Union, Local No. 320 (Social Services Unit) Labor Agreement & Minnesota Merit System), in accordance with the County Affirmative Action Policy and subject to 2007 budget guidelines, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Thiede seconded by Commissioner Franzen the Board then convened to a closed meeting at 11:50 a.m. for the County Administrator's annual review, all members voted "AYE".

Present were all County Board members, County Administrator David Hamilton, Human Resources Director Tamra Laska, County Auditor, Deborah Erickson, and Administrative Assistant Terrie Walseth. Terrie Walseth then excused herself from the meeting.
