

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
CROW WING COUNTY, MINNESOTA  
Meeting held on January 3, 2006

In accordance with Minnesota Statute 375.07, the required meeting of the Board of County Commissioners was held on January 3, 2006, at 9 a.m.

All members were present.

The Board of County Commissioners proceeded to organize for 2006, pursuant to Minnesota Statute 375.13, by opening nominations for the Chairman and Vice Chairman positions. On motion of Commissioner Walters seconded by Commissioner Sluss that Commissioner Larsen be nominated for Chairman for 2006 and the Secretary be instructed to cast a unanimous ballot, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Sluss seconded by Commissioner Tautges that Commissioner Ferrari be nominated for Vice Chairman for 2006 and the Secretary be instructed to cast a unanimous ballot, all members voted "AYE".

On motion of Commissioner Walters seconded by Commissioner Tautges that payment be made to Kurilla Real Estate LTD Trust in the amount of \$1,000 for earnest money for the Solid Waste Coordinator to be able to negotiate for a parcel being offered for sale next to the County Landfill, and the County Auditor is authorized to issue the warrant from the Solid Waste Fund; and further, the Board authorizes the Solid Waste Coordinator to make an offer of \$85,900, all members voted "AYE".

Commissioner Walters offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED Crosby-Ironton Courier be designated as the second publication for the County Financial Statement.

Which resolution being seconded by Commissioner Sluss was duly adopted, all members voted "AYE".

Commissioner Tautges offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, either through request of legal counsel or general consensus of the County Board, meetings have been closed for the purpose of which follows the guidelines in Minnesota Statute 13D for closed meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Commissioners of Crow Wing County, Minnesota, reaffirms the resolution of June 2, 1992, stating that in future cases of labor negotiation strategy, preliminary consideration of allegations against persons employed by the County, evaluations of the performance of persons subject to the authority of the Board and conferences protected by the attorney-client privilege, meetings shall be closed.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED any member of the Crow Wing County Board may, by motion, request to have specific meetings open.
